Main case

Learned counsel for the parties jointly agree that the present
contempt petition can be disposed of with a direction to the Executing
Court to decide the execution proceedings within a period of two
months and definitely by 31.07.2019 even if hearing is to take place on
day to day basis.

In view of the above agreed position, the contempt petition
is disposed of with a direction to the executing court to decide the
execution proceedings positively on or before 31.07.2019 even if day to

day hearing has to take place. It is clarified that neither of the parties shall try to cause delay or seek adjournment. It is also clarified that no frivolous application shall be moved before the Executing Court.
