The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 26.09.2014 (corrected vide order dated 15.05.2015), vide which, direction was issued to the respondents to pay interest @ 9% per annum to the petitioner on all emoluments, other than the amount from the General Provident Fund.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.3 is already on record. As per the said reply, the entire amount due to the petitioner as per his entitlement stands paid. The details of the payment have also been mentioned in para Nos.4 to 6 of the said reply.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner however states that some amount is still pending. This fact is disputed by learned State counsel and states that the calculation of the petitioner is incorrect and no amount is due to the petitioner.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file representation bringing out the

discrepancy in the amount so paid by the respondents, within four weeks

from the receipt of certified copy of this order and the respondents shall thereafter look into the said representation and pass a speaking order within four weeks from the receipt of said representation after granting personal hearing to the petitioner.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
