AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

A writ petition was filed aggrieved that no decision has been taken on the legal notice served on the respondents raising grievance with regard to calculation of arrears. The writ petition was disposed of on 20.01.2017 directing the Chief Administrator and Estate Officer, GMADA to decide the legal notice and re-determine the amount which the petitioner is liable to pay towards arrears of allotment price of four SCFs.

The said representation was decided after sending two communication to the petitioner for providing personal hearing. In response to communication, letter dated 27.06.2017 was sent by the petitioner that in case he is unable to come due to ill health, the

calculations be looked into and order be passed. Thereafter, order dated 15.11.2017 was passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against order dated 15.11.2017.

The contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
