The application is allowed as prayed for. The additional affidavit of Bhupinder Singh son of Late Gurdarshan Singh, Pump Operator E.E.-2, Division No.2, Water Supply & Sanitation Department, Patiala, is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

Main case

The present contempt petition has been filed for disobedience of the order dated 22.9.2008 (Annexure P-1).

No doubt vide order dated 25.10.2018, the respondents were directed to file reply and it was stated by the learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.33 has not been paid any arrears but today learned counsel for the respondent-State has produced the calculation with respect to the arrears qua petitioner No.33. It is stated that arrears have been paid and nothing is due. The said calculation is handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

In view of the above, Rule is discharged. The contempt petition

is disposed of. However, in case any discrepancy is found in the arrears, the petitioners are at liberty to file a representation which shall be decided in accordance with law.
