This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 11.7.2016 as per the detailed order passed in CWP No. 4739 of 2011.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

Consequently, all the seven petitions are allowed. The monetary benefits flowing from this order are directed to be calculated and paid to the petitioner(s) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. The petitioner(s) would be entitled to simple interest at the rate of 6% p.a. on the payments to be disbursed on account of the fact that the Department should have on its own accord similar treatment to the petitioners in the wake of the decision rendered in Neelam Rani's case.

Today reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Dr. Rakesh Gupta, Director General Secondary Education Haryana, Panchkula along with Annexures. It has been stated in the reply that pay of all the petitioners have been fixed and due payment has been released

In view of the reply filed, no cause of action survives in pursuing the present contempt petition. However, the petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law, if still some grievance survives.
