AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

A writ petition was filed raising grievance that construction of multi-level parking in the High Court premises was stalled due to certain reasons. The writ petition was disposed of on 10.05.2010 and U.T. Administration was directed to expedite the construction of multi-level parking and further in the meanwhile to deploy police personnel to manage the traffic inside the High Court premises.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that multi-level parking is operational since long and even there is deployment of police officials to manage traffic inside the High Court premises.

The contempt petition is disposed of, as no cause of

action survives for pursuing the contempt petition.

Needless to add that in case of grievance, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
