Petitioner Suresh Kumar @ Pappal has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in complaint case No.143 dated 16.11.2016 titled as Ashokpal Singh Versus Suresh Kumar @ Pappal and others, for the offences under Sections 408, 166, 466 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant have appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 argues that there are serious allegations against the present petitioner in the complaint.

Perusal of the record shows that it is a complaint case. The

petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation as he is only to face the trial. He has already appeared before the trial Court vide order dated 10.01.2019 passed by this Court and has been released on interim bail. No useful purpose would be served by sending him to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 10.01.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
