Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide the security to the petitioner and for not harassing her on any false criminal complaint, if lodged by any of the private respondents or relatives of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has already made a representation dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) to the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Rohtak and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Rohtak to look into the contents of representation dated 24.12.2018 (Annexure P-1) and to act in accordance with law.

It is made clear that in case, no such representation has been made by the petitioner, it shall not be incumbent upon respondent No.2 to take note of this order.
