This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 28.8.2014 passed in CWP No. 17648 of 2014 and other connected matter.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order thereon, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order."

The State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Sukhjeet Pal Singh, Director Public Instructions (SE), Punjab, dated 19.8.2019. Along with the reply an order dated 14.3.2017 and compliance report dated

10.1.2018 have been filed. Copy of the reply has been supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner. He submits that there is grievance with regard to the order dated 14.3.2017 passed by the respondents and seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

In view of the reply filed, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty aforesaid.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
