SUDIP AHLUWALIA, J. (ORAL)

The grievance of the petitioner, who happens to be the plaintiff in the suit pending before the Ld. Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Assandh (Anneuxre P-1), is that inspite of service of notice upon the defendant/respondent, his application for temporary injunction has not been taken up for consideration at all even though the suit was filed more than a month ago.

2. The matter is now stated to be listed on 4th February, 2019 for filing written statement by the defendant, and even now the pending injunction application has not been listed for consideration.

3. In view of the order this Court proposes to pass, service of notice upon the respondent-defendant would not be called for at this stage, as no prejudice would be caused to him.

4. The matter is thus disposed off with a direction upon the Ld. Trial Court to take up the pending injunction application for consideration and decide the same as expeditiously as possible after notifying the defendant's side, and by fixing a date for that purpose which should be within a week from the date of communication of this order.
