This order shall dispose of three contempt petitions bearing COCP Nos.1479, 2751 and 2871 of 2018, as common questions of law and facts are involved therein. However, for convenience the facts have been taken from COCP No.1479 of 2018.

The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 20.12.2017, vide which direction was issued to decide the legal notice by way of passing a speaking order with respect to the promotion of the petitioners to the next rank on the basis of being physically handicapped.

Mr. Sandeep S. Mann, Sr. Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, on instructions from Mrs. Nirupama Krishna, Deputy Director, Department of Secondary Education, Haryana, submits that the matter involves around 2180 posts of Principal. It is stated that their seniority list shall be finalized within 15 days from today. Thereafter, the roster point of persons with disabilities shall be allotted and the promotions shall be accordingly granted. The entire process qua the posts of Principal shall be completed within 35 days as per the table given in para 10 of the short of reply of Dr.

Rakesh Gupta, Director General School Education, Haryana dated 5.2.2019.

The contempt petitions are disposed of in the above terms with a direction to the respondents to do the needful within the stipulated period of 35 days. In case the needful is not done, the petitioners will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petitions on an application moved by them. If the petitioners are forced to file application for revival, heavy penalty shall be imposed on the concerned officer/official.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
