The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 08.03.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 5552 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Consequently, the instant petition is allowed. The Commission will forward the name of the petitioner to the Government for appointment. Since the petitioner has been put to considerable expense in litigation etc., the Commission shall pay exemplary costs of Rs.50,000/- to the petitioner within a period of one month from today. The costs shall be recovered by the Commission from the erring official/s and officer/s who are found responsible for the culpable mistake.”

Learned State counsel submits that the cost of Rs. 50,000/- has been paid and a committee has been constituted for recovering the cost from the defaulting official. He states that compliance report would be filed in due course of time. It is contended that the commission has forwarded the name of the petitioner for appointment.

Despite of two pass overs, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Dismissed for non- prosecution.

The respondents would file the compliance report with details of recovery made from the erring official within three months with the Registry of this Court.
