Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.154 of 2018 dated 22.12.2018 lodged by respondent No.2 with Women West Police Station, Gurugram for the offences punishable under Sections 120-B, 323, 377, 406, 420, 498-A and 506 of IPC (Annexure P-1) qua the petitioner and the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

The petitioner is sister-in-law of the complainant-respondent No.2.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Manjusha, states that in the aforesaid FIR, police has completed investigation and submitted challan against the other co-accused. However, the petitioner was found innocent in the case and she was, therefore, exonerated.

In view of the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition is rendered infructuous as the petitioner is no more an accused in the present FIR.

Dismissed as infructuous.
