Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.33 dated 06.06.2014, registered under Section 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station D Division, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

It has been submitted that the petitioner was earlier declared proclaimed offender. Now, he has joined the proceedings. Moreover, compromise has been effected between the parties.

Petitioner has also filed a quashing petition i.e. CRM-M-51219-2018, for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise and the same is pending for 02.04.2019.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 14.01.2019, passed by this court, is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
