The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 12.03.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 6029 of 2018. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner shall be considered and dealt with by the respondents within a period of two weeks from today. And, appropriate orders in accordance with law shall be passed.

The petition is accordingly, disposed of, in the above terms. However, in the event, the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondents-authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.”

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply dated 29.06.2018 was filed.

A copy of the reply was received by learned counsel for the petitioner on 04.07.2018. Along with reply, order dated 22.03.2018 was annexed.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the directions of this Court has been complied with and order dated 22.03.2018 passed for redressal of grievance of the petitioner.

Despite of two pass overs, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

Dismissed for non- prosecution.
