The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 17.10.2016.

Reply is filed. As per the said reply needful has been done.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, stated that the respondents were required to take Rs.7250/- as the last pay drawn but have taken Rs.7128/- as the last pay drawn. Secondly, the respondents were directed not to recover the excess amount. However, from the reply, it is evident that the basic pay has been taken as Rs.7250/- as the last pay drawn, and further even the excess amount has in fact been paid back.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.
