Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed praying for quashing of DDR No.24 dated 19.07.2014 (**P-2**), under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, recorded in FIR No.140 dated 11.07.2014 (**P-1**), under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Dakha, Ludhiana along with all consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise (**P-3**) entered into between the parties.
