Petitioners Robin Gill @ Sabhi and Ajay Kumar have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.72 dated 15.11.2018, registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala, under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel and counsel for the complainants have appeared and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

In compliance of order dated 20.02.2019, ₹1,60,000/- has been paid by learned counsel for the petitioners to the complainants, who are present in person. Learned counsel for the complainants has no objection regarding grant of bail to the present petitioners. He also says that the complainants are ready to compound the offence and for quashing of the

FIR on the basis of compromise as no dispute remains between the parties.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 14.01.2019, passed by this Court, the petitioners have already joined the investigation and in view of the compromise effected between the parties, they are not required for custodial interrogation. No useful purpose would be served by sending them to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 14.01.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
