The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 15.6.2016 passed in CWP No. 12531 of 2016.

In the writ petition, interim direction was granted to the petitioners that they would be permitted to continue in service beyond 30.6.2016 till regular appointments are made or whichever is earlier.

Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions states that regular appointment has been made vide order dated 5.10.2016 and said order had been handed over to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
