AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 21.12.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No.3988 of 2015.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced below:-

“17. Directions are issued to release to the petitioner the financial benefits on the basis of fixing his honorarium while serving as member of District Consumer Disputes Redressal Forum, Ropar as last pay drawn minus pension as per option exercised by him.

18. Needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

Ms. Surinder Kaur, Deputy Secretary, Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs is present in the Court

and states that an amount of ₹1,47,592/- is to be paid and ₹10,08,917/- has already been paid. She further states that needful will be done within 10 days from today and detailed calculation of amount will also be provided to the petitioner.

In view of statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of.

It is clarified that if the statement made today in the Court is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. In case the petitioner is forced to do so, exemplary costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.
