Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no grievance survives for pursuing the present contempt petition.

However, on the last date of hearing i.e. 04.07.2019 an order dated 06.03.2018 was produced in Court to show the compliance of order dated 19.01.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No. 6005 of 2011. It was ordered that the officer who had passed the order dated 06.03.2018 shall remain present in Court alongwith the relevant record on the adjourned date.

Today, neither the concerned officer has come present nor the record is produced. It is submitted that the officer has since been retired.

Learned counsel for the respondent very fairly submits that there is fault on the part of the respondent for not serving the order keeping same with them for almost more than 16 months and respondent is ready to bear the costs.

A cost of ₹10,000/- is imposed, to be deposited with the Poor Patient's Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh, the cost shall be recovered from the defaulting officer/official after holding an inquiry. The compliance report in this regard be sent to this Court.

At this stage learned counsel for the respondent submits that the compliance report will be furnished within three months from today along-with the receipt of deposit of costs.

Disposed of, as infructuous.
