The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 12.5.2017, vide which, direction was issued to release the pension and other benefits like leave encashment, gratuity, GPF and whatever is found due.

Reply has been filed. As per the para Nos.4 to 6 of the said reply, the pensionary benefits, in terms of the detailed speaking order dated 4.8.2017 (Annexure R-1), have been released to the petitioner, which includes temporary service for the period from 14.9.1973 to 12.5.1983 has also been treated as qualifying service while computing pensionary benefits. Besides that same, death-cum-gratuity has also been deposited and the regular pension has also been sanctioned.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
