Plaintiff-petitioner is in the revision petition against the dismissal of application for grant of temporary injunction. At the time of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the resolution passed on 18.06.2018 is illegal through which Sh. Sukhdev Singh, a self-proclaimed President was removed. It will be noted here that the resolution dated 18.06.2018 has not been challenged by the plaintiff-society. Still further, it is pleaded case that Sh. Rajinder Singh Sidhu was elected President of the society and since he was to go abroad, therefore, he is alleged to have appointed Sh. Sukhdev Singh as acting President. Sh. Rajinder Singh Sidhu was also involved in a criminal case but he has now come out on bail. In such circumstances, the plaintiff who was only appointed as an acting President in absence of Sh. Rajinder Singh Sidhu, has no right.

In view thereof, there is no ground to interfere.

Revision petition is dismissed.
