AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

These two contempt petitions have been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 27.05.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No.15574 of 2014 and are being disposed of by a common order. For convenience, facts are being taken from COCP No.1629 of 2018.

The aforesaid writ petition was allowed by this Court in view of decision of this Court in CWP No.6315 of 2012, titled as ***Suman Nain Vs. State of Haryana.***

The respondents have filed the reply annexing sanction order dated 19.06.2019 and copy of pay order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the retiral benefits have been released and interest has been given, still there is grievance regarding interest awarded.

In view of sanction order dated 19.06.2019, no further interference is required in the contempt petition.

Both the contempt petitions are disposed of as infructuous. The rule issued against the respondents is discharged.

Needless to add that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law to redress the grievance.
