In the present writ petition, the petitioner is seeking mandamus directing the respondents to grant one advance increment upon the upgradation to the post of District Veterinary Inspector and also grant the arrears w.e.f. 01.05.2012.

From the pleadings as well as the documents attached with the present writ petition, it is clear that the petitioner has not filed any representation claiming the above-said relief from the respondents and has directly approached this Court. No mandamus can be issued till a claim has been made by the petitioner from the respondents.

Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioner states that she be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation/legal notice.

Present writ petition stands disposed of with liberty aforesaid.

In case any representation/legal notice is submitted/served by the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today, the respondents shall decide the same by passing an appropriate order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation/legal notice, if any.

It is made clear that this Court does not express any opinion on the merits of the case and the claim being made in the present writ petition or the representation/legal notice to be filed by the petitioner before the respondents.
