Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr.Ravinder Singh, Superintendent, (Incentive), Department of Industries and Commerce, Punjab, states that incentive/subsidies under the Industrial Policy, 1996, have been released along with 6% interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to contradict the said statement, due to lack of instructions.

There is no reason to disbelieve the statement made by the learned counsel for respondents.

Disposed of.

In case, the statement made found is factually wrong, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.

Learned counsel for the respondents assures the Court that the detail of the amount found due shall be provided to the petitioner within four weeks from today.

It is, however, clarified that in case there is any grievance with regard to calculation, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
