The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 29.11.2018 vide which a direction was issued to pass a speaking order, keeping in view, the judgment rendered in the case of **CWP No.9300 of 2015 titled as Menka Versus State of Haryana and others and Mrs. Rita Tandon Versus State of Haryana and others .**

Reply has been filed. As per the said reply, the case of the petitioner has been decided by way of a speaking order dated 06.09.2018 vide which it appears that the respondents followed the policy dated 20.07.2017 directing all Principals of Government Colleges to pay Rs. 25,000/- per month including vacations.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, at this stage learned counsel for the petitioner states that the said amount due to the petitioner has not been released. In case, the amount, so due to the petitioner, is not released within four weeks from today, the petitioner is

at liberty to revive the present contempt petition and in case they are forced to revive a heavy penatly shall be imposed on the respondents.
