Prayer in the petition is to quash the FIR No.293, dated 26.11.2018, registered under Sections 341/323/506/34 IPC, at Police Station City Sangrur, on the basis of compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur, has been received, in which it has been stated that the FIR in question has ceased to exist as cancellation report has been accepted. The relevant part of the report is extracted as under:-

“It is submitted that as per statement of complainant Happy Kumar and HC Jagtar Singh, Investigating Officer of this case, applicant Lucky Kumar is not nominated in the present FIR and FIR was got registered only against Karan Kumar and 3-4 unknown persons. Furthermore, the police has presented the cancellation report on the basis of compromise and as per the

affidavit submitted by complainant Happy Kumar before the Police, in which complainant Happy Kumar has suffered the statement that he has agreed with the investigation conducted by the police and he has no objection if the cancellation report is accepted. Thereafter, the cancellation report was accepted by this Court.”

In view of the aforesaid report, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
