ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 45, dated 10.05.2018, under Sections 307, 326 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he is alleged to have caused single knife blow to the injured. The injured has fully recovered. The petitioner is 24 years of age and is in custody for over 01 year and 05 months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Amritpal Singh states that although the charges have been framed but none of the 09 prosecution witnesses has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 01 year and 05 months and

conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
