Learned counsel for the petitioner is not disputing the fact that 1st, 2nd and 3rd ACP, revised leave encashment and withheld gratuity amount have been paid to the petitioner. He raises a grievance that revised pensionary benefits are pending and no decision has been taken by the respondents on claim of interest on the delayed payment.

Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Rajesh Duggal, Law Officer, O/o Director, Development & Panchayats, Haryana submits that amount of revised pensionary benefits would be credited in the account of the petitioner within three weeks from today. It is further submitted that decision with regard to the claim of interest would be taken within 4 weeks from today. In case any amount is found due, the same

would be paid within 4 weeks thereafter.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.
