AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 03.05.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No.9233 of 2017.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“In this view of the matter, we relegate the petitioner-Association to approach the above-stated Authority within one week whereupon the Regulatory Authority shall call for the records and redress the petitioner's grievance in accordance with law and keeping in view the powers vested in it under the provisions of 2016 Act. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of submission of the petition.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.”

On the last date, learned State counsel placed on record order dated 09.08.2018 whereby representation filed by the petitioner has been decided.

None had appeared for the petitioner on the last date. Even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner inspite of two pass-overs.

In view of order produced, the contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

However, petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if aggrieved of order passed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
