The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.696 dated 03.06.2012, registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 IPC (wrongly mentioned as 460 instead of 406 in the impugned order dated 30.10.2018), at Police Station City, Panipat.

Earlier the petitioner was on bail. During the trial, he could not appear before the learned court below, therefore, his bail/surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to State and lateron vide order dated 18.03.2017, he was declared proclaimed offender.

The petitioner is in custody since 11.09.2018. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody any further.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Prince alias Shahbaj Singh

is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
- (d) He will maintain peace and be of good behaviour.
