The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 22.09.2017 vide which liberty was granted to move an appropriate application in the matter in case the terms and conditions of the settlement between the parties were not adhered to.

It is stated that as per the settlement, the minor child was permitted to meet the petitioner on every Wednesday and Sunday for seven hours but the same was not being honoured. Learned counsel for the respondent has placed on record copy of order dated 22.11.2018 passed by the Principal District Judge, Family Court, Gurugram vide which both the parties have suffered a mutual statement, which is as under:

“Stated that the petitioner/father shall pick the child Abhiveer from the residence of the respondent/mother on Wednesdays at 4.00 p.m. and shall drop the child at 8.00 p.m. at the residence. On Saturdays, the petitioner-father shall pick the child at 11.00 a.m. and shall drop him back at 5.00 p.m.

In view of the above schedule the present petition may be dismissed as withdrawn.”

In view of the said statement, the execution petition was dismissed as withdrawn.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present contempt petition. The same is accordingly dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
