The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 26.09.2017, vide which a direction was issued to respondent Nos.3 and 4 to decide the representation of the petitioner by passing a speaking order.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Indu Malhotra, DPI (Colleges), Punjab filed in Court is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioners.

It is not disputed that the matter has been decided and the amount due to the petitioners has been paid.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

Learned counsel for the petitioners however states that no interest has been paid to the petitioners, if it is so, the petitioners are at liberty to avail remedy as available to them, in accordance with law.
