The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 30.09.2014.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Sunder Lal, HFS, Divisional Forest officer, Jhajar on behalf of respondent No.3 is filed today in Court. The same is taken on record. As per the said reply, they have regularized with effect from 01.10.2003.

In view of the same, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, states that while considering the regularization, arrears of salary have not been paid to the petitioners as per their entitlement.

The petitioners are at liberty to file fresh representation within two weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. The respondents shall decide the question of back wages within one month from the receipt of the said representation by way of passing of a speaking order. In case, they are

found entitled to the same, the said back wages shall be disbursed to the petitioners with another two months of the decision of the said representation.
