Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.372 dated 02.12.2017 under Sections 452, 379-B, 324, 323, 294, 506, 427, 148, 149, 325, 326 IPC, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana.

While granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 09.01.2019: -

“.....Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that while granting interim anticipatory bail to co-accused Ajay Partap Singh, following order was passed on 03.12.2018 in CRM-M-52232-2018: -

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant, after 20 days of registration of FIR, suffered a supplementary statement in order to trace the accused, he has investigated at his own level and came to know that the

petitioner alongwith other co-accused have caused injuries to him and committed the offence. He further submits that two co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Harkirat Singh and Gurpreet Singh, have been granted concession of bail. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gursewak Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner be directed to join investigation.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gursewak Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.01.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
