AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

A writ petition bearing CWP No.8780 of 2012 was filed by the Gram Panchayat being aggrieved of change of mutation in favour of the Forest Department with regard to certain land. The writ petition was disposed of with the direction that revenue entry was in name of petitioner and mutation shall not be changed without notice to the petitioner and after hearing the objections.

The present contempt petition has been filed relying upon the internal communication dated 14.12.2017 which is with reference to orders passed by the Supreme Court dated 07.09.2009 and order dated 02.04.2009 of this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to show that the said communication pertains to the land involved in

CWP No.8780 of 2012.

No case is made out for wilful disobedience of order of this Court.

The contempt petition is dismissed.

However, learned State counsel, on instructions, states that in case the mutation entries with regard to land in dispute in CWP No.8780 of 2012 are to be changed, that would be done in consonance with the directions dated 10.05.2012 of this Court.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
