Parties except respondent No.1 are present along with their respective counsel.

The petitioner has got her statement recorded separately before this Court stating therein that the compromise was arrived at between the parties towards full and final settlement against payment of Rs.20.00 Lakhs. She has received Rs.13.00 Lakhs and balance amount of Rs.7.00 Lakhs is still due to her. It is further stated that she will make a statement before the Family Court, Yamunanagar at Jaghadahri on 29.04.2019 when the case for grant of divorce is listed, in case the balance amount of Rs.7.00 Lakhs is deposited by the respondents on or before 28.04.2019.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that respondent Nos.2 and 3 are present in the Court and also undertake for depositing the aforesaid balance amount on or before 28.04.2019 in the account of the petitioner.

In view of the above statement made by the petitioner and the undertaking given by the counsel on behalf of the respondents, the present contempt petition is disposed of with a direction to the parties that they shall remain bound by their respective statement and undertaking. In case, the amount is not deposited in the account of the petitioner on or before 28.04.2019, the petitioner will be at liberty not to make the relevant statement before the concerned Court and the Family Court shall accordingly adjourned the matter fixed before it for a further date and in the meanwhile, the present contempt petition shall stand revived on an application moved by the petitioner.

Similarly, in case the petitioner does not honor her statement made before this Court, the present contempt petition shall once again stands revived but this time to be proceeded against the petitioner. The petitioner is also made to understand that the said compromise shall fall through in case she does not make the appropriate statement as per compromise and she will be bound to return the amount to the respondents with interest.

Disposed of with the above terms.
