The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 25.5.2016 vide which a direction was issued to the respondent to decide the claim raised in the legal notice dated 28.9.2015 and to decide the issue.

Reply has been filed. It has been specifically stated in paras No.3 and 4 that the amount towards treatment amounting to Rs.2,56,273/- has been paid to the petitioner as per the entitlement and also interest of Rs.69,355/- on the delayed amount.

In view of the same, the contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

However, in case the petitioner finds any discrepancy in the said amount, he is at liberty to file representation bringing the said fact to the notice of the respondent within one month from today. In case such a representation alongwith the calculation is filed, respondent shall consider the same in accordance with law and pass appropriate order within one month of the receipt of the representation.
