Present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for quashing of F.I.R. No. 09, dated 17.02.2015, under Sections 353, 186, 323 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhuri, District Sangrur and subsequent proceedings arising thereof.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the matter in controversy had already practically come to an end as there was a settlement between the petitioners as well as the complainant's side and the matter was investigated by the police.

The police has submitted untraced report to the Court but the same was not accepted by the learned trial Judge on 16.12.2016 and the Court ordered for re-investigation. As per direction of the Court, police again investigated the matter and the matter further remained untraced.

Untraced report was again submitted before the Court and the same was returned by the learned trial Judge on 10.02.2018. Investigating Agency again investigated the matter and submitted report, but the Court returned the file without passing any order.

At any rate, as per the Investigating Agency, there is nothing against the present petitioners in this case and present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR and the continuation proceedings on the basis of that shall be sheer wastage of the court time.

In view of above, the instant petition is accepted. Consequently, the impugned FIR No. 09, dated 17.02.2015, under Sections 353, 186, 323 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhuri, District Sangrur and all other consequential proceedings arising thereto are hereby quashed, qua the petitioners only.
