AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the retiral benefits have been released. He raises a grievance that the claim with regard to interest on the delayed payment has not been considered by the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions from Shri Bhupinder Singh, Sr. Assistant, O/o Director, Treasury & Accounts, Punjab, submits that the issue of interest will be dealt within six weeks from today and in case the petitioner is found entitled to interest, the same would be released within six weeks thereafter.

In view of above, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition, the same is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

It is made clear that in case the afore-said statement made today in Court is not adhered to, petitioner would be at liberty to revive the present petition. In case of revival, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting officer/official.

In case petitioner is aggrieved of order passed, he would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
