Learned counsel for the parties are *ad-idem* that the directions of this Court with regard to counting of past service rendered by the petitioner in the earlier corporation and computation of retiral benefits have been complied with.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that payments of arrears were made late but no interest is granted whereas the respondents have charged interest under various heads.

He further submits that in view of above, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for the redressal of grievances with regard to charging interest under various heads and for claiming interest on the delayed payments.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.
