**KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)**

Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 4.1.2019. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexure P-4. The true typed copy of Aadhar Card of petitioner Nos.1 and 2, showing their date of birth have been placed on file as Annexures-P-1 and P-2 along with their affidavits respectively. The true translated copy of the marriage certificate has been placed on file as Annexure P-3.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 4.1.2019 (Annexure-P-5) before the police authorities for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to consider the application of the petitioners dated 4.1.2019 (Annexure-P-5) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be taken to be the proof of valid marriage. Disposed of accordingly.
