By this petition, the petitioners are seeking direction to the respondents to regularize their services as per policies dated 18.03.1996 (Annexure P-5) and 01.10.2003 (Annexure P-6).

The petitioners have joined the Forest Department-respondent No. 2 from 1986 to 1992. The details of their services have been mentioned in para 2 of the writ petition. In para 4 of the writ petition, the petitioners have given names of their juniors whose services have been regularized vide order dated 21.08.2018 passed by this Court in ***CWP-10419-2016 Hawa Singh and another V/s. State of Haryana and others*** (Annexure P-3). The petitioners are claiming parity that their services should be regularized keeping in view the directions given by this Court in the case of ***CWP-2009-2016 Balwinder Singh and others V/s. State of Haryana and others*** (Annexure P-4).

A legal notice dated 31.10.2018 has been sent in this regard (Annexure P-2).

Ms. Palika Monga, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

This petition is being disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to consider legal notice dated 31.10.2018 (Annexure P-2) keeping in view the judgments passed by this Court in *Hawa Singh's case* (Annexure P-3) and in *Balwinder Singh's case* (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order failing which Rs.50,000/- will be deposited in the account of each petitioner as costs and this Court be informed the order passed.
