The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 30.06.2014, vide which a direction was issued to consider the case for grant of industrial incentive to the petitioner as per Industrial Policy, 1996, in accordance with law.

Short reply by way of affidavit of D.P.S. Kharbanda, Director of Industries and Commerce, Punjab on behalf of the respondents is filed today in Court. The same is taken on record. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said reply, order has been complied with and claim of the petitioner has been accepted vide order dated 28.12.2018.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the interest has been pending. There is no specific direction to the said fact. Accordingly, the petitioner is at liberty to avail remedy as available to him, in accordance with law, for seeking the said interest.
