The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 3 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report by way of affidavit on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 in Court along with the statements i.e. Annexures R-1/T to R-4/T. The same are taken on record. Copy given to the opposite counsel. He has apprised the Court that both the petitioners in their respective statements (Annexures R-1/T and R-2/T) mentioned that they are living happily and do not apprehend any danger from anybody. Statements (Annexures R-3/T and R-4/T) of Ashok Kumar and Sneha (respondents No.4 and 5), father and mother of petitioner No.1, have also been recorded, wherein they have expressed no objection to the alleged marriage between the petitioners.

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At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition, as the alleged threat has vanished.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is allowed to be dismissed as withdrawn.
