The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 3.10.2017 vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner.

Admittedly, the representation was considered and after considering the petitioners have since been granted benefits from August 2018.

In view of the same, no contempt is made out.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, states that they should give benefit atleast from the date of the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court and not just from August 2018, whereas, there was no such direction by this Court.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to avail the remedy as available to him in accordance with law.
