The present contempt petition has been filed alleging willful disobedience of the order dated 02.08.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 12581 of 2014.

The afore-said writ petition was allowed in terms of judgments passed by this Court in cases **A.P. Sharma and others vs. State of Punjab and others;** in CWP No. 25733 of 2012, decided on 22.10.2013 and **Karanvir Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others;** in CWP No. 2866 of 2014 decided on 30.09.2016.

In view of the order of this Court, the pension of the petitioners were to be refixed.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the orders for re-fixation of the pension of the petitioners. The same are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners state that there is a grievance against the order passed by the respondent as the basis of the said order is instructions dated 02.08.2017 which has been superseded by the instructions dated 04.07.2019 and the order cannot be sustained.

There is a fresh cause of action to the petitioners, in view of instructions dated 04.07.2019.

In view of above, no cause of action survives in the present petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

The rule issued against the respondent is discharged.

The petitioners can avail remedy against the order, in accordance with law.
