The writ petition was disposed of on 04.12.2014 with the directions to the respondents to decide the legal notices (Annexure P- 7 and P-8 in the writ petition) by passing a speaking order in the light of the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in ***Gurmail Singh Dahdli and others versus Union of India and others, 2008 (3) S.C.T. 234***. This contempt petition has been filed pleading that needful has not been done.

Learned counsel for the respondent has produced order dated 15.02.2016 whereby decision has been taken on the legal notices. The copy of order was also sent to Mr. Ajit Malik, Advocate who had given the pre-contempt legal notice in 2015. Copy of the said order is handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against the order passed.
