In this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner was ordered to be admitted to anticipatory bail, vide an order passed on 11.04.2019.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been found to be innocent in the investigation conducted by the District Police of Gurdaspur, however, subsequently, on the directions of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot, i.e. the District in which the FIR was registered, the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused in the report submitted under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hem Raj, submits that the report having been submitted, in fact the petitioner has been admitted to bail by the trial Court itself and therefore, this petition has been rendered infructuous.
